Dear Dr Reynolds,

Just a few observations regarding your product FlightPath. The product was recommended to me by Chris Knowles, a good friend and fellow fancier. I do not have race birds at my location, just stock birds and your product has been used during the breeding season. I certainly believe FlightPath has had a beneficial effect on the birds and their progeny. FlightPath was used in the following manner:

Prior to pairing the birds together the whole flock are given FlightPath.

When the young birds hatch and reach approximately 8 to 10 days of age, FlightPath is added to their water for one day. This I feel helps with immunity against disease and the natural bacteria are given an extra boost within the young bird. Just as significant, the parents, which are about to produce another pair of eggs, are also in top condition.

FlightPath is given again when the young birds reach 24 days old, just prior to moving to another environment.

I have individual watering facilities for each breeding pair, this helps a great deal as I only mix the amount of FlightPath I require at a given time. I give approximately half a teaspoon (2.5ml) to the birds concerned in approximately half a pint (250ml) of water. I use bottled spring water.

I have no hesitation in recommending FlightPath to other fanciers and wish you luck with future sales.
